CONTRACT

The undersigned Exhibitor applies to the North Hatley Antique Show (hereinafter called the SHOW) for the right to use exhibition space as hereinafter set out for the display and sale of the Exhibitor's merchandise to the public at the SHOW in the North Hatley Curling Club on Friday July 4, 2008 from 6:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., Saturday July 5, 2008 from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., and on Sunday July 6, 2008 from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. This application is subject to the conditions *on the attached document* (which conditions are made part of this application/contract). It is understood and agreed by the undersigned that this application shall constitute a contract binding upon the Exhibitor and the SHOW when accepted as to the specified exhibition space by the Show Director, on behalf of the SHOW.

The Exhibitor's deposit, as specified in the clause 9 below, of the rental fee for the booth space is enclosed herewith, dated **March 15, 2008** together with a post-dated cheque for the balance payable **June 1, 2008**, failing which the contract may be terminated and the deposit will be returned to the Exhibitor. The SHOW reserves the right to negate this contract and any money will be refunded prior to the SHOW.

Conditions of Contract

The Exhibitor's application for, and the SHOW'S grant of, exhibition space as described in the Contract is made subject to the following conditions:

1. Exhibits will be open to the public on Friday July 4, 2008 from 6:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., Saturday July 5, 2008 from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and Sunday July 6, 2008 from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
2. To ensure a location, a deposit (as per the Contract) of the rental fee along with the signed Contract is to be submitted to the Vendor Convenor by March 15, 2008 together with a post-dated cheque for the remainder of the rental fee, dated June 1, 2008.
3. Exhibitors must bring their own heavy-duty extension cord to facilitate access to the electrical supply. Ample lighting will be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. Limit is 500 watts per booth.
4. Two (2) 8' tables and two (2) chairs are provided at no charge. We can only guarantee 8' tables; any other size you would be advised to bring your own. All other display requirements are the responsibility of the Exhibitor.
5. Exhibitors will keep all aisles clear of exhibits and will confine all canvassing demonstrations, distribution of literature and like activities to the exhibition space covered by the Contract.
6. Operation of public address systems will NOT be allowed.
7. In the event of any disagreement between the Exhibitor and/or the SHOW, the decision of the SHOW'S Chairperson will be accepted.
8. A Vendors' Permit must be available upon request.
9. The Exhibitors agrees to be completely set up prior to the scheduled opening. Set-up time is Thursday July 3, 2008 from 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Friday July 4, 2008 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. *Please indicate which day you will be setting up.*
10. The Exhibitor agrees that displays will not be dismantled, packed or removed from the display area until 5:00 p.m. on Sunday July 6, 2008.
11. All items must be for sale and the prices clearly shown.
12. **NO REPRODUCTIONS** are to be offered. The organizers of the SHOW have the right to request the removal of non-conforming goods.
13. No alcoholic beverages or smoking are permitted in the North Hatley Curling Club.

14. Liability

The Exhibitor shall, from the date of the move-in into the rented space, be responsible for his own exhibits for the duration of the exhibition, including the move-out period.

15. Insurance

The Exhibitor shall, from the date of the move-in into the rented space, until the date of the move-out maintain adequate theft and liability insurance.

16. Indemnification

16.1 - The Exhibitor covenant to protect, indemnify and hold harmless the SHOW or North Hatley Recreation Society, the owner and the management of the building where the exhibition is held, the directors, officers, employees, representative and agents of all organizations herein mentioned against any and all claims for damage to property, destruction or loss thereof and for injury to or death of any person in the rented space, the said building or the approaches and entrances thereof with may result from or be connected with the occupancy of the said building and space by the Exhibitor.

16.2 - The Lessor and the owner of the premises will not be responsible for any damage of whatever nature sustained by the Exhibitor including cancellation of the Exhibition for reasons of force majeure or otherwise, unless such damage be caused by their gross negligence or that of their agents and employees.

17. Cancellation of the Exhibition by Lessor

Should the Lessor deem it necessary to cancel the Exhibition for any purpose whatsoever, all monies will be returned to the Exhibitor. The Lessor shall not be liable for any expenses, damages or losses, cost or claims by the Exhibitor.

18. Joint and Several

If more than one person or corporation sign the present agreement as Exhibitor, their obligations shall be construed as being joint and several, each such person or corporation being obliged to the performance of the whole and waiving the benefits of division and discussion.

19. Governing Law

The present agreement shall be governed by the laws of the Province of Quebec.

20. Language

The parties specifically declare that they have requested the present document be drawn up in the English language. / Les parties déclarent qu'elles ont expressément demandé que ce contrat soit rédigé en anglais.
